#### **Counselor Review**

- Applications are due March 1<sup>st</sup> but we will continue to take applications through the first full week of the fall semester.
- Shadowing starts November 1<sup>st</sup> and runs through the first week of May.
- All programs take juniors and 1st year seniors. Enrollment is based on application points.
- Under normal circumstances school districts will be billed for students on Northland Career Center's roster after the second day of class.
- Last date to enroll in Northland Career Center's classes is the first full week of school.
- All students earn embedded English credit
- All students earn embedded math credit except students attending Park Hill School District and West Platte

### Agricultural Sciences Early College Program:

- Focus is on earning an Associate's Degree in one of the following pathways
  - o Agriculture Agribusiness
  - o Animal Science
  - o Plant Science
- Students attend class at MCC Maple Woods locations
- 15 to 20 hours of college credit per year
- Students may enroll for a semester or year but it takes 2 years to earn the Certificate of Achievement

### Aviation Technology:

- Focus is on Aviation Mechanics (Structure, HVAC, Engine, Ground Service)
- Certifications earned
  - USI Drone Operation
  - o OSHA 10
  - Snapon Multimeter
- Students may earn 18.5 hours of articulated credit through
- Internships available through Aviation Technology Services at KCI Airport

#### Construction Technology:

- Focus is on learning the basics of building a house from the ground up
- Certifications earned
  - o Carpentry Level 2
  - Carpentry Level 3
  - o OSHA 10
- 2 year completers may join Carpenters Union at Level 2 or 55% of apprenticeship completed
- 11 hours of dual credit through MCC
- 12 hours of articulated credit through MWSU
- Construction internships available throughout the Northland

# Culinary Arts:

- Focus is developing skills to become a head chef or baker and connecting with Chefs in the Northland
- Certifications earned
  - Certified Fundamentals Cook from ACF
  - o OSHA 10
  - o Food Handler's Certification
  - o ServSafe Manaer's Certification
  - SP/2 Food Safety Kitchen Safety, etc.
- 6 hours of articulated credit and 3 hours of credit by exam through JCCC
- 3 hours of articulated credit through CIA
- 7 hours of articulated credit through OTCC
- Internships available throughout the Northland

#### Diesel Technology:

- Focus is on earning ASE Entry-Level certifications and working on heavy/light duty diesel equipment
- Certifications earned
  - ASE Diesel Engines
  - o ASE Electrical/Electronic Systems
  - ASE Brakes
  - o ASE Steering/Suspension
  - ASE IMMR (Inspection/Maintenance/Minor Repair)
- 4 hours of articulated credit through OTCC
- Internships throughout the Northland. Recently focused on MHC Kenworth/Road Builders

### Health Sciences:

- Focus is on learning practical skills and vocabulary to take the written and hands-on CNA test
- One year program for juniors or seniors
- Student must have their own transportation second semester
- Certifications earned
  - Certified Nursing Assistant
  - o CPR
  - First Aid
  - Stop the Bleed
  - o OSHA 10
- 6 hours of dual credit through MCC

### Heating, Cooling, & Climate Control:

- Focus is on problem solving & troubleshooting HVAC systems to become a HVAC Technician
- Certifications earned
  - o H.E.A.T
  - o OSHA
  - o Section 608 EPA
  - o Refrigeration
- 11 hours of dual credit through MCC
- 12 hours of articulated credit through MWSU
- Internships throughout the Northland

# **Industrial Welding:**

- Focus is on learning 3 types of welds; Mig/Stick/TIG
- Certifications earned
  - o AWS Welder Performance
  - o OSHA 10
  - o AWS SENSE Level 1
  - o SP/2 Welding
- 19 hours of dual credit through MCC
- 12 hours of articulated credit through MWSU
- Internships throughout the Northland focused on manufacturing/Railroad/Car shops

#### IT Professional:

- Focus is on hardware, networking, and tech support
- Certifications earned
  - TestOut PC Pro
  - o TestOut Network Pro
  - o CompTIA A+
  - CompTIA Network +
- 12 hours of dual credit through MCC
- 9 hours of dual credit through UCM
- 12 hours of articulated credit through MWSU
- Internships throughout the Northland but focused on Cerner

### Law Enforcement/Crime Scene Investigation:

- Focus is on Criminal Justice system with emphasis on law enforcement and crime scene investigation
- Certification earned
  - o Industry Recognized Credential thru the Missouri Peace Officers Association
- 6 hours of dual credit through MSU
- Transcripted credit Criminal Justice
- No internships at this time but working with KCPD in developing options

### **Teaching Professions:**

- Focus is on building teaching portfolios and working as a cooperating teacher 3 days a week
- Certification earned
  - AAFCS Education Fundamentals
  - CPR
  - o ParaPro/Substitute Teacher In the works
- Recommended that students have their own transportation as they may work off-site 2nd year
- 9 hours of dual credit through NWMSU

## Industrial Automation & Robotics - Formally KC Tech Academy:

- Focus is on programming and working on automated machines with a focus on robotics and electrical
- Certifications earned
  - Fanuc Robot
  - o OSHA 10
- 16 hours of dual credit through MCCC
- Internships throughout the Northland but focused in the manufacturing fields
